In case you didn't know, Easter is right around the corner. It's a big deal for us as followers of Christ because it represents the day that Christ overcame the power of death, and it's that event that gives us our hope for a future with Him. So, this is a great day to invite people to check out our Church.

Did you know?

- 82% of people invited to an Easter Service will say likely attend.
- Only 2% of church members invite an unchurched person to church.
- 35% of people would be likely to attend a church if they knew people there "are like me."
- You might be inviting them to the place they belong.
- 7 out of 10 unchurched people have never been invited to church.
- If you don't invite them, who will?
- 2% of people who attend church will do so because of a church advertisement compared to 86% who attend because they were invited by someone they know.
- They are looking for a church that is involved in the community.
- You are inviting them to Easter could be the most important invitation they ever receive.
