**Last week's question and answer:** How did Jesus heal the blind man? ***He covered his eyes with clay and told him to wash (John 9:6-7)***

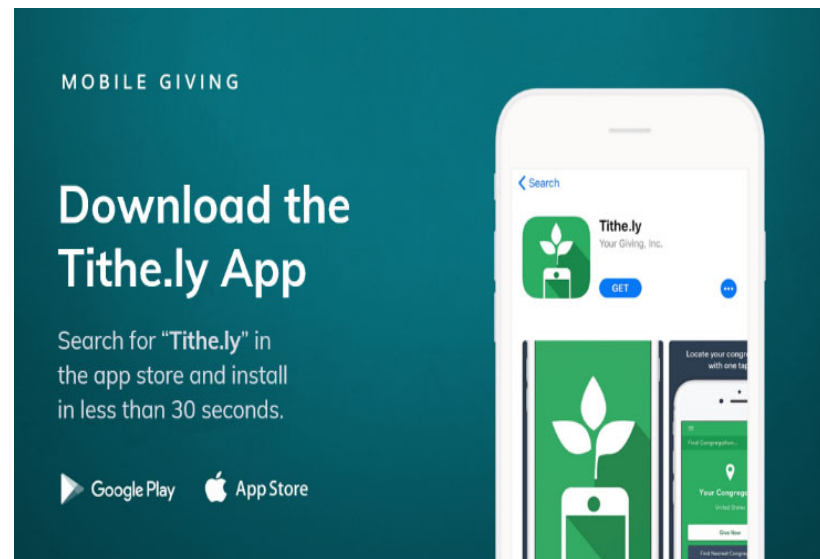
