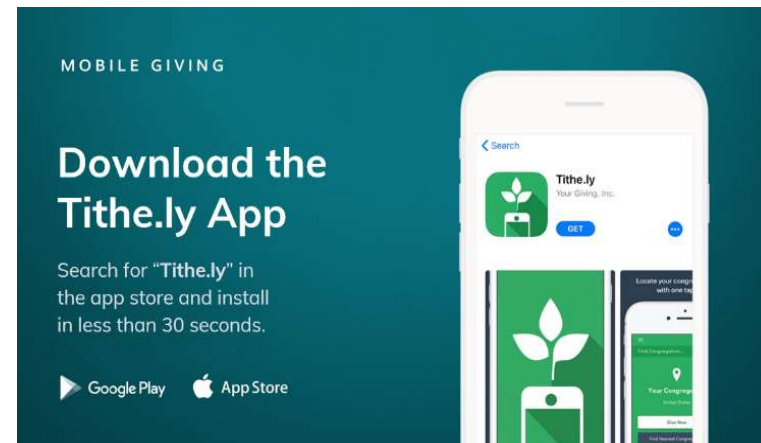

MILITARY BIBLESTICK
