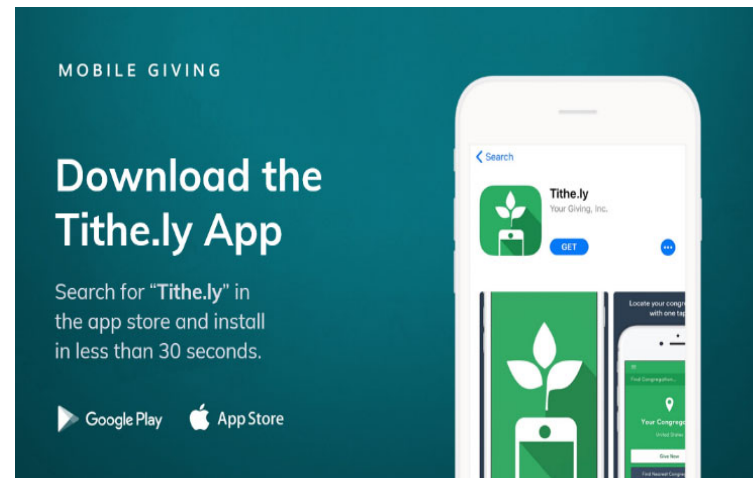

## MISSIONS (PUTTING FAITH INTO ACTION)

### MILITARY BIBLESTICK
