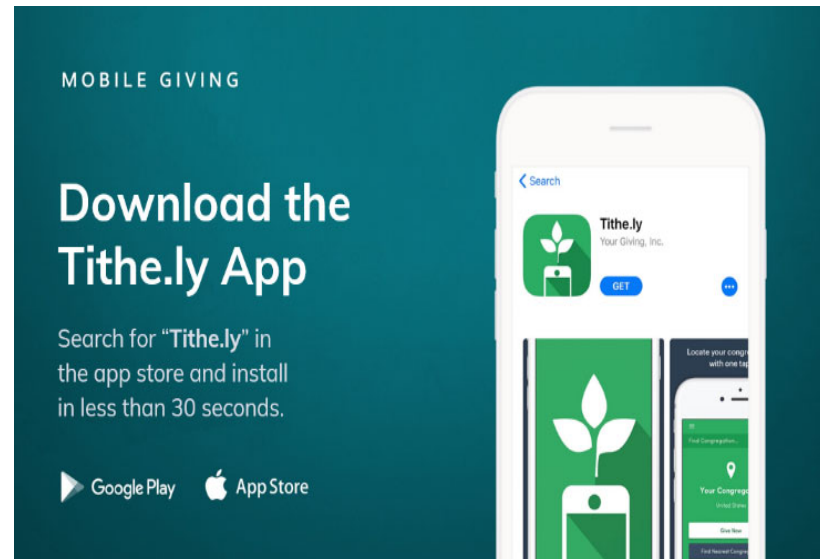
## INSPIRATIONAL QUOTE

### THE GIDEONS

Our June Mission Project is the Gideons. Our own John Hodgkiss has been involved in this ministry for many years and has expressed that there is a financial need.

The Gideons is a 120-year-old Christian organization of business and professional men & women. The Gideons have the unique opportunity in placing Bibles & New Testaments in the hands of people in hard to reach places of the world and is currently doing this in 190 countries.

The Gideons have people trained and ready to distribute all of the scriptures that they are supplied. However, the need is great, and many areas are begging for more Bibles and New Testaments.

For every \$5 donated; a Bible or 4 New Testaments can be placed. Every Bible placed lasts about 6 years and over 2,000 people will see it and open it up. Here is a chance for us to partner with one of our own members in his ministry.
