MISSIONS (PUTTING FAITH INTO ACTION



Servant's Heart Ministry runs a Workmanship Program which provides students 18 years old and older an introductory trades education taught by industry professionals. Located in a 4,200 sq.ft. warehouse, they offer hands-on experience to give students exposure to a career in each of the key trades: general construction, plumbing, electrical, and masonry at no cost to the student.

There is no certification associated with the completion of the Workmanship Program, but during the semester the students will be given the opportunity to get certified in CPR, First Aid, and OSHA at no cost.

Our mission project will be to collect money towards a a car lift for their upcoming automotive program. They have someone that has a gently used Mohawk lift that would suit our needs. He's willing to install it for \$12,000, which is a HUGE bargain. As we raise money for that lift, it would allow them to start the build out of that space and get going with that program in 2024!

Special Note: Servant's Heart Ministry helped out our church several years ago as we had a a large amount of termite damage around our Fellowship Hall windows and several doors. They came in and did the work for us as we would have been unable to do the work ourselves.
