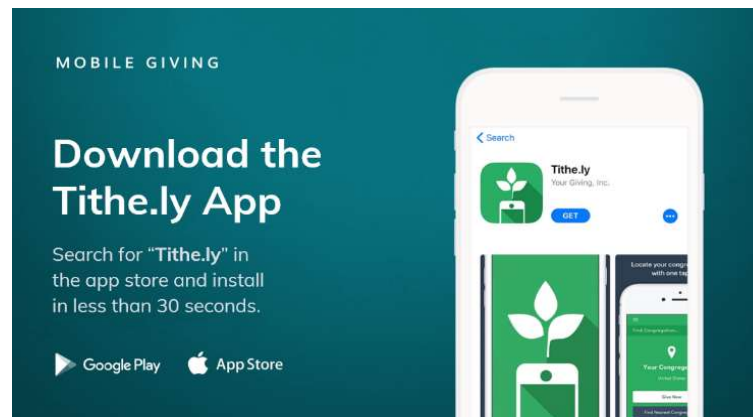
RVBC SUNDAY SCHOOL
