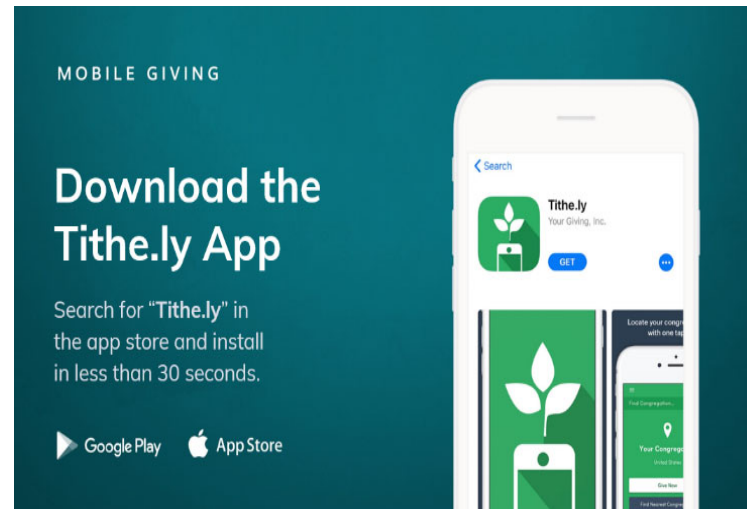

OCTOBER MISSION PROJECT
